The Board heard updates from the following Elected Officials:

Jerry Vander Sanden, County Attorney, and Nick Maybanks, Asst. County Attorney - discussed a bump of a Victim Witness Coordinator in their office. They are working with Human Resources on a possible remedy.

Joan McCalmant, Recorder - boat legislation bill did not pass; will be presenting at upcoming Recorder's School; cross training deputies.

Joel Miller, Auditor - upcoming bump of employee in Elections; discussed Iowa gift law and potential policy (Supervisor Harris will address with Jimmy John's); Primary Election turnout numbers are low; attending Intrapreneur Academy along with Deputy's Law and Stonawski; will participate in EntreFEST Thursday and Friday; working on cyber security as it related to elections; Homeland Security representative was on site yesterday and reviewed the summary of findings.

Becky Shoop, Deputy Auditor - discussed an employee's idea to change the process of confidential shredding bins; working with Darrin Gage on legislation that passed for no longer having to publish resolutions in the minutes (required to have resolutions available on website) and NOD's (Notice of Deposit) will no longer have to be issued.
