The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.
Present: Chairperson Harris, Supervisors Rogers and Oleson. Absent: Vice Chairperson Houser and Supervisor Walker (personal business). Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Harris called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Oleson to approve Consent Agenda as follows:

Resolution 2018-7-93

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2018, the Linn County Board of Supervisors rescind the appointment of Leslie T. Beck as Interim Building Official.

Resolution 2018-7-94

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2018, the Linn County Board of Supervisors appoint Luke Maloney to the position of Building Official and to remain so until such time as this appointment is rescinded.

The Building Official is authorized and directed to enforce all the provisions of the various building codes and their referenced technical codes. For such purposes, the Building Official shall have the power to render interpretations of these codes and their referenced technical codes.

Authorize John Harris, Board of Supervisors Chair, to electronically sign Amendment #1 of contract 588HC08 between the Iowa Department of Public Health & Linn County Community Services/Ryan White Program authorizing an additional \$3,488 in Capacity Building and \$349 in Administration funding for the remainder of the contract period, April 1, 2018 - March 31, 2019, increasing the amount to \$289,529.

Authorize Chair to sign Release of Mortgage of June 28, 2013, made and executed by the East Central Iowa Council of Governments, in association with Linn County's Single Family New Construction Grant, regarding property commonly known as 5821 Hertz Drive, Marion, Iowa.

Approve and authorize Chair to sign contract for services, in the amount of \$98,500, between Linn County Early Childhood Iowa Board and Linn County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of Linn County Community Services Child & Youth Development, for the Nurturing Parenting program.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Oleson to approve upon third and final consideration of Ordinance #5-7-2018, proposed amendments to Chapter 105, Article III Electrical Installations, of the Linn County Code of Ordinances.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Oleson to approve upon second consideration of an ordinance entitled An Ordinance Amending Chapter 10 of the Code of Ordinances, Linn County, Iowa, by Adding Thereto a New Article VII Pertaining to the Control of Lead-Based Paint Hazards.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Oleson second consideration of an ordinance entitled An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances, Linn County, Iowa, by Repealing and Replacing Provisions in Chapter 20, Article III Relating to the Linn County General Assistance Program.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Oleson to approve upon second consideration of an ordinance entitled An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances, Linn County, Iowa, by Amending Provisions in Chapter 20, Article II and Adding a Provision in Chapter 20, Article II Pertaining to the Department of Community Services.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Oleson to approve Claims #70603371-#70603484 in the amt. of \$219,675.66; ACH in the amt. of \$1,480,304.36; payment to ARC in the amt. of \$425.00 and Arleen Zahn-Houser in the amt. of \$1,483.68.
