GENERAL INFORMATION

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Linn County Code of Ordinances is published pursuant to the authority and by the direction of the Linn County Board of Supervisors.

The Linn County Attorney is responsible for [1] the review of all proposed ordinances or amendments to ordinances prior to those proposed ordinances or amendments thereto being placed on the agenda for formal consideration (reading or other action) by the Board of Supervisors; [2] providing legal advice to the Board of Supervisors and other County officials with respect to the scope and effect of County ordinances and proposed ordinances; and [3] maintaining a current Code of Ordinances that is available to the general public on the Linn County web-site (listed below), viewable at at the Cedar Rapids Public Library or the Linn County Law Library.

The Linn County Auditor is responsible for: [1] maintaining all resolutions establishing or affecting the Code of Ordinances; [2] publishing and distributing the Code of Ordinances to County offices; [3] publishing and distributing the Code of Ordinances and amendments to private persons or organizations for a reasonable fee; and [4] maintaining a current Code of Ordinances that is available to the general public.
