

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA  
MONDAY, JUNE 8, 2020 12:00 P.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.  
Present: Chairperson Rogers, Vice Chairperson Oleson and Supervisor Walker. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Rogers called the meeting to order.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Walker to approve minutes of June 3, 2020 as printed.

Update on Linn County's response to COVID-19:

Supervisor Rogers stated that Pramod Dwivedi asked if he could provide updates on Wednesday's going forward. Rogers stated that there are 1,013 cases in Linn County with 80 deaths.

The Board discussed potential impacts of opening the building next week including the door and entryway not yet being completed and without an estimated completion date as well as the Q-matic upgrade which may not be completed until early July. A Board Support Team meeting is scheduled for tomorrow with a decision being made for a reopening date on Wednesday.

Darrin Gage, Dir. of Policy & Admin. presented a contract with Per Mar Security Services for temporary security officer services in response to COVID-19 Pandemic for the Public Service Center, Community Services Building and Harris Buildings. The security guards will doing line management, typical security and symptom checking.

The Board also discussed the plans for symptom checking at the Courthouse and Juvenile Justice Center since they have deputies already working in those buildings.

Garth Fagerbakke, Facilities Mgr., presented proposed change order #1 from Garling Construction for the Mental Health Access Center in the amount of \$34,078.86 noting that this is for 17 different items. The Board will approve Wednesday.
