

11.6 Employment

1. In order to obtain assistance under the provisions of this ordinance beyond the initial month, each adult member of the applying household, not suffering from a disability, must actively seek employment for which the household member is qualified.
 - a. Should a “needy” applicant need a second month of assistance in a given twelve month period of time the applicant must attend a career/resource orientation presentation at the General Assistance Office. The applicant will need to provide the General Assistance Office their certificate of completion prior to being granted a second month of assistance in a given twelve month time period.
2. Termination for absenteeism from previous employment or voluntary withdrawal from the workforce by any adult member of the applying household, not suffering from a disability, shall result in the applying household being deemed ineligible for assistance under the provisions of this ordinance for a period of two months from the date of termination or withdrawal.
 - a. Ineligibility for assistance would be waived if the applicant is able to get a new job and provide the first paystub of earnings at the new place of employment. Temporary employment agency pay is excluded from this discussion.
