

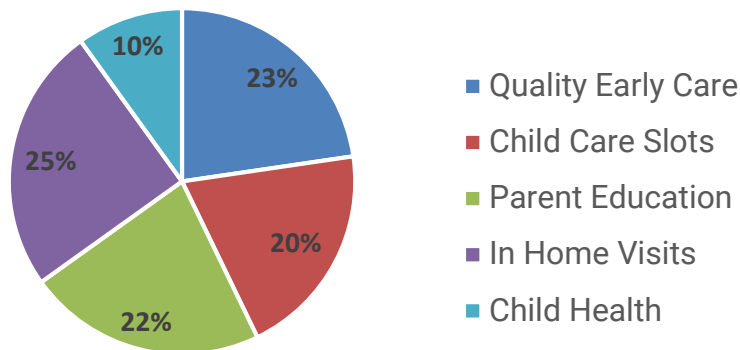

- Total FY 19 ECI Funds Allocated to Board: \$1,505,870
 Total ECI Funds Expended in FY 19: \$1,542,777 (Used \$36,907 of carry forward \$)
- 95.8% expended on Programs
 - 4.2% expended on Staff and Board Administration
